



GRADUATION RATES

COHORT PERIOD 09/01/11 TO 08/31/12

A Graduation Rate calculation is based on a group of students who did not attend another college or university prior to attending New England College of Business. These students enrolled from September 1, 2011 - August 31, 2012 and completed their program within 150% of the program's length. In addition, certain students are excluded from the rate above in accordance with National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) guidelines and as reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Student Data System (IPEDS).

- Subsidized federal loan recipients who did not receive federal grants
